

**STUDENT COOPERATIVE ASSOCIATION, INC.**  
**AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**  
**CHARTER NO. 4115**

(As approved by Indiana County Court, September 7, 1925, And  
Amended January 25, 1960, January 29, 1973, October 1, 1979 and December 8, 2005).

1. The name of the Corporation shall be "THE STUDENT COOPERATIVE ASSOCIATION, INC."
2. The purposes for which the Corporation is formed are the maintenance of a perpetual association for the educational, literary, social, recreational and cultural benefits of the students and faculty of Indiana University of Pennsylvania, Indiana, Pennsylvania, or its successors by whatever name known to conduct and operate a book store and other facilities for said persons, to receive activities fees and other payments in the conduct of said activities and for these purposes to have the right to acquire, hold, own and lease such real and personal property and to borrow money and give such evidences of its indebtedness as may be necessary to carry out the corporate purposes. This Corporation does not contemplate pecuniary profit, incidental or otherwise, to its members.
3. The place where the business of the Corporation is to be transacted is at Indiana, Indiana County, Pennsylvania.
4. The Corporation is to exist perpetually.
5. The Corporation has no capital stock.
6. (Lists the original subscribers.)
7. The Corporation is to be managed by a Board of Directors of seventeen (17) members under the following groupings, who shall hold their offices for such terms and shall be selected in such manner as prescribed by the By-Laws of the Corporation:
  - a. The President of IUP or his Designee (*Must be a member of Management*)
  - b. Management (2): Two members of IUP Management
  - c. Faculty (4): Four members of IUP faculty
  - d. Students (9): Nine members of the IUP student body
  - e. Trustee (1): One member of the Board of Trustees

8. The Corporation shall have as its officers a Chairperson, a Vice-Chairperson, Secretary and Treasurer. In addition, the Board may appoint such assistant officers as mandated by the needs of the Association. The officers chosen by the Board of Directors shall hold their office for such terms as shall be prescribed by the By-Laws in the Corporation.
9. Admission to membership and the requirements thereof shall be as prescribed by the By-Laws, subject to the provisions of the Constitution and laws of the United States and of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
